


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# 1 d&b U-Series Wall and Ceiling mounts



## 1.1 Intended use

### Preliminary remark:

Throughout these mounting instructions, the application and assembly procedures are shown and described for the U5 loudspeaker as an example. The same application and assembly procedures also apply to the U3 and U7 as well as to the U3N, U5N and U7N loudspeakers.

The d&b U-Series Wall and Ceiling mounts are intended for mounting a single loudspeaker to walls or ceilings or other suitable surfaces. The mounts must only be used as described in these mounting instructions.

## 1.2 Safety precautions

### General safety

- Installation and setup should only be carried out by qualified and authorized personnel observing the valid national Rules for the Prevention of Accidents (RPA).
- It is the responsibility of the person installing the assembly to ensure that the suspension/fixing points are suitable for the intended use.
- Always carry out a visual and functional inspection of the items before use. In case there is any doubt as to the proper functioning and safety of the items, these must be withdrawn from use immediately.


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### NOTICE!

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The U-Series Wall and Ceiling mounts are designed to carry the weight of a single U-Series cabinet.


**2.2 Mounting options and angle settings**



The Z5810 U-Series Wall mount allows the applicable U-Series loudspeakers to be deployed either vertically (upright) or horizontally to walls or other suitable surfaces.

The Wall mount [1.3] itself provides two holes (slots) at an offset distance of 20 mm (0.8") to allow the entire assembly to be closer or farther to/from the wall.

Depending on the on-site conditions and surroundings, the cabinet can be continuously aligned vertically and horizontally within the following angle ranges:

- The vertical aiming (tilt) can be set in the range of up to 80° (+40°/-40°). For precise aiming the tilt unit [1.1] provides a scale with detents of 5°.
- The horizontal alignment (pan) can be set in the range of up to 90° in both directions.

## 2.3 Assembly

### 1. Wall mount - Fixing template

#### NOTICE!


It is the responsibility of the person installing the assembly to ensure that the fixing points, fixing anchors, and screws are suitable for the intended use.

- ⇒ As a first step, attach the Wall mount **[1.3]** to its intended operating position on-site.
  - ↳ For this purpose, the Wall mount can be used as a fixing template.

### 2. Preparing the cabinet


**Tool required:** Torque wrench #13 mm.

1. Depending on the desired orientation of the cabinet (vertical or horizontal operation), observe the direction of attachment, as shown in the graphic below.




**Direction of attachment: Vertical | Horizontal operation**

2. Attach the tilt unit **[1.1]** to the threaded inserts **[1]** at the rear of the cabinet using the enclosed U-washers **[2]** and hex head screws **[3]**.



3. Attach the pan unit **[1.2]** using the enclosed U-washers **[2]** and self securing nuts M8 **[4]**.
4. Preset the desired vertical tilt angle and tighten the nuts.
  - ↳ For this purpose, the tilt unit **[1.1]** provides a corresponding scale with detents of 5° while the pan unit **[1.2]** provides a related marker **[M]** (arrow mark).

### 3. Attaching the entire assembly to the Wall mount




**Tool required:** Torque wrench #13 mm.

1. With the Wall mount **[1.3]** already fixed to its operating position, attach the entire assembly to the desired holes **[H]** (slots) of the Wall mount.
2. Attach the U-washers **[2]** and self securing nuts M8 **[4]** and slightly tighten the nuts to fix the assembly in place.
3. Set the desired horizontal orientation and tighten the nuts **[4]**.

### 4. Checking the assembly

1. Finally recheck your work and ensure all screws and nuts are properly fitted and tightened.
2. If required, attach the secondary safety device to the safety point **[S]** of the tilt unit.


#### 3.2 Mounting options and angle settings

The Z5810 U-Series Ceiling mount allows the applicable U-Series loudspeakers to be deployed horizontally to ceilings or other suitable surfaces.

Depending on the on-site conditions and surroundings, the cabinet can be continuously aligned vertically and horizontally within the following angle ranges:

##### Vertical alignment

The vertical aiming (down tilt) can be set in the range of up to 90°. For precise aiming, the tilt unit [1.2] provides a scale with detents of 5°.



### Horizontal alignment

The horizontal aiming is achieved with the Ceiling mount **[1.1]** itself.

For this purpose, the fixing plate is equipped with four rounded elongated holes of 9 mm (0.35") arranged in a circle which allow the horizontal aiming of the cabinet in the range of 30° (15° in each direction).

If more than 15° are required (e.g. 25°), the Ceiling mount has to be mounted with a corresponding offset (e.g. 10° related to 25°) towards the desired direction.

**Alternatively**, the center hole of 11 mm (0.43") **[C]** can be used to enable continuous horizontal alignment.


## 3.3 Assembly


### 1. Ceiling mount - Fixing template

#### NOTICE!

It is the responsibility of the person installing the assembly to ensure that the fixing points, fixing anchors, and screws are suitable for the intended use.

- ⇒ As a first step, attach the Ceiling mount **[1.1]** to its intended operating position on-site.
  - ↳ For this purpose, the Ceiling mount can be used as a fixing template.







## 2. Preparing the cabinet

**Tool required:** Torque wrench #13 mm.

1. Observe the direction of attachment, as shown in the graphic below.



2. Attach the tilt unit [1.2] to the threaded inserts [1] at the rear of the cabinet using the enclosed U-washers [2] and hex head screws [3].



## 3. Attaching the entire assembly to the Ceiling mount

**Tool required:** Torque wrench #13 mm.

1. With the Ceiling mount [1.1] already fixed to its operating position, attach the entire assembly to the Ceiling mount.
2. Attach the U-washers [2] and self securing nuts M8 [4] and slightly tighten the nuts to fix the assembly in place.
3. Set the desired vertical aiming (down tilt) and tighten the nuts [4].
  - ↳ For this purpose, the tilt unit [1.2] provides a corresponding scale with detents of 5° while the Ceiling mount [1.1] provides a related marker [M] (arrow mark).

## 4. Checking the assembly

1. Finally recheck your work and ensure all screws and nuts are properly fitted and tightened.
2. If required, attach the secondary safety device to the safety point [S] of the tilt unit.
